

Brian Tomlin is the William and Josephine Buchanan Professor of Management and the incoming Senior Associate Dean of Faculty and Research at the Tuck School of Business at Dartmouth. He is a Department Editor for the Manufacturing & Service Operations Management journal. He is also past President of the Manufacturing & Service Operations Management society. Brian's research lies in the broad domain of operations and supply chain management, with a particular interest in the areas of supply chain risk and operations innovation. With co-authors, he received the 2012 Wickham Skinner Award for Best Paper published in Production & Operations Management, was a finalist for the 2013 Manufacturing & Service Operations Management Best Paper Award, and was a finalist for the 2012 INFORMS Daniel H.
